

A.T. JAY TRUST

The AT Jay Trust, founded in 1916 by Alfred Thomas Jay, exists to offer financial support to ministers who are in active service. The remit of the Trust is to offer grants to ***Free Church Ministers***, being Ministers who require or desire a ***temporary rest from active work*** due to ill health or for the ***enhancement of their ministry***.

Typically the Trust offers grants of up to £500 to applicants who can show how their situation meets the criteria above. The trustees meet twice a year to consider applications. The deadlines for applications are:

- **April (to be considered in May)**
- **September (to be considered in October)**

If you feel you might qualify for a grant, please compose an application with the following information:

- Your name and details of your ministry situation
- Why you are asking for funding and how that fulfils the above criteria
- Total cost of your project, how much you have already raised, and how much you are asking for from the Trust.
